*****NOTICE***** SOUTH WEBER WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT CUSTOMERS

Dear Customers,

The South Weber Water Improvement District greatly appreciates the efforts made by its customers in following the watering guidelines and doing their best to conserve water. We ask that all customers continue to be responsible in their use of secondary water. The following guidelines will be in place for this coming season:

- Water will be turned on April 22, 2024, and will be shut off when we run out of our contracted amount of water.
 - Remember to close your own user valves before water turns on to prevent any unwanted water as we start filling the system.
- In May, June, September, and October customers may water up to 2 watering cycles per week on the days listed below.
- In July and August, as needed, customers may water up to 3 times per week on the days listed below.
- A water cycle equals a maximum of 20-minutes for spray nozzles and 40minutes for rotor style heads.
- Odd numbered houses may water on: Monday Wednesday Friday
- Even numbered houses may water on: Tuesday Thursday Saturday
- Please do not water during the hottest part of the day.
 - Remember: Secondary water is untreated, unfiltered water that is used for the irrigation of outdoor residential landscaping and gardening. This water is non-potable (not suitable for human consumption) and should not be used for outdoor recreation (filling pools or playing in sprinklers).
