SOUTH WEBER WATER
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT CUSTOMERS

Dear Customers,

The South Weber Water Improvement District greatly appreciates the efforts made by its customers last year in following the watering guidelines and doing their best to conserve water. We ask that all customers continue to be responsible in their use of secondary water. The following watering guidelines will be in place for this coming season.

- Water will be turned on **May 1, 2023**, and will be shut off when we run out of our contracted amount of water.
- **In May, June, September, and October** customers may water up to 2 watering cycles per week on the days listed below.
- **In July and August**, as needed, customers may water up to 3 times per week on the days listed below.
- A water cycle equals a maximum of 20-minutes for spray nozzles and 40-minutes for rotor style heads.
- **Odd numbered houses** may water on: Monday - Wednesday - Friday
- **Even numbered houses** may water on: Tuesday - Thursday - Saturday
- Please do not water during the hottest part of the day.

To help with water conservation please consider the following:

- Check your timers to make sure the settings are correct and replace the batteries in case of power outages.
- Mow your lawn at its highest mower setting.
- Mulch your grass clippings – they will help decrease evaporation.
- Aerate your lawn - this will improve its drought resiliency.
